TRIAL COMMITTEE

If your dog is not ASCA® registered you must have a Qtracking number in order for your titles to be counted. However a Qtracking number is not required to compete. Qtracking number applications can be found at asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/06/qtsvcapp.pdf and will be available at the trial.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From the south: Take I-15 North to Exit 289: Bangerter. Turn left on Bangerter and go approximately 3.8 miles. Turn left on 2700 West. At 4 way stop (0.7 mi.) turn right onto 14400 S, 2834 W is the second house (gray house) on the right. Turn in at 2nd driveway and drive back past the barn to park.

From the north: Take I-15 South to Exit 289: Bangerter. Turn right on Bangerter and go approximately 3.5 miles. Turn left on 2700 West. At 4 way stop (0.7 mi.) turn right onto 14400 S, 2834 W is the second house (gray house) on the right. Turn in at 2nd driveway and drive back past the barn to park.

MOVE-UPS

After submitting your entry form, we will accept move-ups or changes *in writing only* (or e-mail to Wasatchwasc@gmail.com) through May 6, 2024 at 6PM. No changes will be accepted after this date. There will be no same day move-ups during the trial. Move-up forms must be completed and turned into the score table within 30 minutes of the end of the last class on Saturday.

AWARDS

First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all classes and levels. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying run.

REFUNDS

There shall be **no** refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.

EQUIPMENT

Rubberized contacts: Slatted 5'6" A-Frame (set at 5'0" for dogs jumping 4" and 8"), Teeter, and Dog Walk; Open Tunnels (24" diameter, 15' and 20'); Weave Poles (24"); Displaceable Tire Jump; Double Jump, Winged and Non-Winged Jumps.

TRAINING IN THE RING

Toys may be brought into the arena for training purposes. These toys may not involve food or treats of any kind, may not make noise, or may not leave parts behind. All handlers declaring toys will mark the gate sheet with a "T" at the run check-in and will run in their regular place on the running order. Upon entering the ring, handlers must declare to the judge that they have a toy. They will be immediately eliminated whether or not the toy is used and will have the specified time for training in the ring. If handlers bring a toy in the ring without declaring it, they will be asked to leave immediately. It is permitted to toss a toy a short distance but remember that the dog aggression rules are in effect for dogs who leave the ring to retrieve a toy. (Effective June 1, 2019)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ASCA agility trials are open to purebred and mixed breed dogs and you do not have to have an ASCA registration or QTracking number to participate.
- If your dog is an ASCA registered Australian Shepherd include your dog's ASCA registration number on the entry form.
- If your dog is not ASCA registered and you would like to earn ASCA titles, you will need to obtain an ASCA QTracking number and include it on the entry form. An ASCA Service Membership and QTracking Number Form is included with this premium and is also available at www.asca.org.
- The postmark (not the delivery date) will determine the entry order. Any Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without recipient signature.
- There will be a \$25.00 service charge for any returned check. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- Confirmations and other communications are sent primarily via e-mail. It is your responsibility to make sure that the secretary's e-mail address Wasatchwasc@gmail.com is allowed by your spam blocker, and to change options that strip attachments from emails.
- Final confirmations will be sent to the e-mail address provided on the entry form after closing date. If an exhibitor has <u>not</u> received a copy of the confirmation within 7 days of the closing date, contact the Trial Secretary at <u>Wasatchwasc@gmail.com</u>.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

This trial is sanctioned by the Australian Shepherd Club of American with Wasatch Working Australian Shepherd Club as the sponsoring club.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial including the following:

- All healthy, trained dogs over eighteen (18) months of are eligible to compete in ASCA agility trials.
- Exhibitors should always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike fashion.
- Bitches in heat, lame or blind dogs are ineligible for entry.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in sufficient control to perform all the obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- Exhibitors agree that if their dog(s) is (are) left unattended, they will be secured in a crate or x-pen.
 Owner/handlers whose dogs are tethered or improperly secured will not be allowed on the show grounds.
- No food, toys, tents, crates or other aids or devices shall be permitted within 10' of the ring.
- All dogs shall be on leash when not competing.
- Safety shall always be the foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The sponsoring club will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result is accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.
- The organizing committee may not refuse any entry other than on the basis expressly provided through rules and regulations of the sanctioning organization. Anyone not currently in good standing with ASCA will not be allowed to enter the trial.
- Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption list, description of classes, levels and division are included in the current ASCA Agility Rules and Regulations Handbook. A copy of the handbook may be downloaded free from the ASCA website: <u>www.asca.org</u>.

And the Adven-Chair Continues!!

Compete in the 2024 WWASC ASCA sanctioned agility trials to be eligible for the Ultimate Agility Adven-Chair. You must compete in at least 2 of the 3 2024 WWASC ASCA agility trials to be eligible. Each 10-point Q is worth 1 point and a 5-point Q is worth 1/2 point. Trial dates to qualify: May 11 - 12, Jun 8 - 9, and Oct 5 - 6. WWASC will award the High Point Aussie and Highest Point Non-Aussie with an agility chair with table, and a free entry to a WWASC agility trial (up to \$ 170 value).

AGREEMENT

IMPORTANT LEGAL AGREEMENT—Please read the following carefully as it, among other things, may prevent you from suing ASCA® and persons/entities affiliated with it. This agreement could even require you to defend them from demands and suits by third parties that include an assertion of wrongdoing by you. (1) The person signing this Agreement represents being authorized to enter into it on behalf of him/herself, as well as (if different) the owner(s)/exhibitor(s)/handler(s) of the dog(s) for which an entry form is being submitted (all these parties collectively referred to herein as "Applicant"). (2) "Releasees" here collectively refers to the Australian Shepherd Club of America® (ASCA®); its affiliate clubs; and the officers and board of directors, staff, contractors, insurers, attorneys, and agents of ASCA® and of those clubs. (3) This Agreement voluntarily is entered into by Applicant in exchange for the acceptance of the associated entry form and permission to participate in related activities. (4) Applicant agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA® and any other rules and regulations applicable to this event. (5) Applicant certifies that the entered dog will not pose a hazard to people, property, stock animals, or other dogs, and further that the dog is current with rabies shots along with any other vaccinations required by its state of residence. (6) Applicant acknowledges and assumes the risks to Applicant and Applicant's dog associated with participation in the event, among which could be ones associated with poor condition of the facilities and surrounding areas; security measures or lack of them; electrical appliances; fittings; show rings; the presence of unfamiliar persons; and the presence/involvement of other animals—whether stock, dogs, or otherwise. (7) Applicant further agrees to comply with all recommended and required health and safety precautions, among which may be those related to social distancing; quarantining; wearing of face coverings; and non-participation of persons exhibiting symptoms or for whom there otherwise has been a likelihood of recent exposure to COVID-19 or other contagious diseases. (8) Applicant additionally acknowledges and agrees to assume the risks associated with taking part in the event though others might neglect compliance with health and safety precautions/requirements or pose an undue risk of spreading disease. For example, as is true as to any public event, there is some risk that Applicant and/or those affiliated with Applicant may catch COVID-19 or another contagious disease at the event. (9) To the maximum extent permissible, this release is to be interpreted under Texas law, without application of its choice of law rules. (10) To the extent that Applicant-or another party suing on behalf of Applicant, or suing to recover based on injuries/death/damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property-sues ASCA® (or a board member or staff member or agent of ASCA®) as a defendant, the sole appropriate forum (to the maximum extent permitted by law) for the suit shall be the state or federal courts serving Brazos County, Texas (where ASCA® has its headquarters). (11) Applicant hereby releases and waives any claims Applicant otherwise might assert against the Releasees as to any injury or damage claim connected in any way to any alleged act or omission arising out of, or occurring concurrent with, the event and related activities, interactions, communications, and even adjacent premises. (12) This release is made not only as to Applicant but also for anyone who might assert a claim on behalf of Applicant or based on purported injury or damage to Applicant/Applicant's dog/Applicant's property, as well as any heir, beneficiary, assignee, executor, trustee, agent, or survivor of Applicant. (13) Applicant further agrees to assume sole responsibility for and indemnify and hold Releasees harmless from related claims, demands, judgments, and settlement payments. (14) These waiver, release, and indemnification provisions extend even to claims or demands asserting that the acts or omissions resulted in bodily injury or death or from intentional wrongdoing, as well as to attorney fees and other costs of defense. (15) The duties of indemnification further extend to any claims or demands asserted against Releasees that are alleged to have arisen out of the acts or omissions of Applicant, Applicant's dog, or others affiliated with Applicant. Among other things, this means that Applicant would pay the legal defense of Releasees if someone sued them based on a claim Applicant carelessly exposed the claimant to COVID-19. (16) Applicant's promises in this agreement apply without regard to the type of claim or cause of action asserted against Releasees. (17) To the extent any provision of this agreement is unenforceable, the remainder of it nonetheless is to be enforced. (18) This agreement is to be interpreted to provide Releasees with the maximum permissible legal protection from-among other things-claims and suits pursued by Applicant (and/or those acting on behalf of Applicant or over injury/damage to Applicant), as well as from ones based on the purported wrongful acts or omissions of Applicant. (19) Nothing in this Agreement requires you to indemnify Releasees from claims by third parties that involve no allegations of improper acts or omissions by you, those affiliated with you, nor your dog(s). (20) Applicant acknowledges having read, understood, and had the opportunity for independent legal review of this document prior to signing it.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the total cost for a QT number?

The cost for membership (required) is **\$20 per owner** if not already a current member.

- Membership expires in one year and only needs to be renewed if applying for another dog after membership has expired.
- Owners will need to renew their membership each year to keep track of dog's scores/titles in the online member portal. To sign up for an online account, please visit www.asca.org and click "Register" under Member Login (must have member ID#).

Membership fee in addition to the QT number fee of \$20 per dog.

A QT number is good for the lifetime of the dog and will not expire.

For one dog with one owner, the total cost is **\$40**. For two dogs with one owner, the total cost would be **\$60**. For one dog with two owners, the total cost would be \$60. (This is assuming no owners are current members or under 18).

Do I have to have a QT number to compete?

- You do not need a QT number to compete in ASCA Agility, Stockdog or Dock Jumping events, unless you want to earn ASCA titles.
- You must have a QT number to compete in ASCA Obedience, Rally and Tracking Tests.

Why would I need or want a QT number for my dog?

To have ASCA keep track of your scores and receive title certificates for your accomplishments.
